### GEOGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION

With 86 mountains including Mount Washington, the highest peak in the Northeast, plus nine notches (called "gaps" or "passes" in other parts of the country), and the 780,000-acre White Mountain National Forest. The region is famous for its beautiful panoramic views.

Loon Mountain is located in the heart of The White Mountains, on Northern New England's only federally designated "Scenic Byway," the Kancamagus Highway. Just two hours directly north of Boston, MA, and two miles off Interstate 93, Loon is extremely accessible.
