### Portsmouth Peace Treaty Anniversary, 1905-1907 commemorations

In 1905, Portsmouth hosted diplomats from Russia and Japan who conducted negotiations at the Portsmouth Naval Shipyard to end "World War Zero." The Treaty of Portsmouth was signed on Sept. 5, 1905 and President Theodore Roosevelt won the 1906 Nobel Peace Prize for his role. The Greater Portsmouth Chamber of Commerce offers a Portsmouth Peace Treaty Trail walking tour (436-3988) and the exhibit "An Uncommon Commitment to Peace: Portsmouth Peace Treaty 1905," is open daily, May 26-Oct. 31, 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. \$8.
