

New Hampshire's Farm and Garden Tour

4 Days in Western New Hampshire

Best Time to Visit: May through October

Day 1 – Southern New Hampshire

- Start in [Hollis](#) where you can enjoy a garden tour and nature walk at [Beaver Brook Association](#) (1).
- Stop for breakfast or lunch at [Parker's Maple Barn](#) (2) in Mason, where visitors can learn about the maple sugaring process. Remember to send home a delicious souvenir from the Corn Crib Gift Shop.
- Take a tour or go on a scenic horseback ride at the [Inn at East Hill Farm](#) (3) in Troy.
- Enjoy downtown [Peterborough](#) and shop at [Depot Square](#) (4).
- Continue on to historic [Keene](#) for an overnight stay.



Day 2 – Greater Keene

- Shop for New Hampshire Made products at [Hannah Grimes Marketplace](#) (5) in Keene.
- Learn about organic gardens, dairy cows, Belgian horses, maple sugaring, crafts, and more at [Stonewall Farm](#) (6), also in Keene. Bring boxed lunches to eat at the picnic areas and remember, milking occurs everyday at 4:30PM.
- Make sure to shop at the historic [Colony Mill Marketplace](#) (7) in Keene.
- Take a short trip to [Boggy Meadow Farm](#) (8) in Walpole to learn about the cheese making process.
- Enjoy a show at Keene State College's [Redfern Arts Center on Brickyard Pond](#) (9).
- Overnight in Keene.

Day 3 – Connecticut River Byway

- Follow the scenic Connecticut River Byway north to [Saint Gaudens](#) (10) in [Cornish](#) for a garden and nature tour. Remember to also explore the historic covered bridges and mills in Cornish.
- Have lunch at [Lui Lui's](#) (11) in [Lebanon](#).
- Explore [The Fells Historic Estate](#) (12) and gardens in [Newbury](#).
- Stay in [Sunapee](#) for dinner and overnight.



Day 4 – Heading South

- Visit [Stonyfield Farm](#) (13) in [Londonderry](#) for some scrumptious yogurt samples and learn about early days on the farm.
- **Some other ideas on the way:**
 - Shop at the [Tanger Outlets](#) in [Tilton](#). Remember, shopping in New Hampshire is tax-free!
 - Take a tour of [Canterbury Shaker Village](#), the living museum in [Canterbury](#).
 - Tour [New Hampshire's Statehouse](#) in the quaint city of [Concord](#).
 - Take an [Anheuser-Busch Brewery](#) tour in [Merrimack](#).
