

elevated courses for different ability levels. The course includes dozens of elements that will challenge you to new heights! Open Memorial Day to Columbus Day.

History suggests that the first zip-lines were built by people living in mountainous regions – particularly the Himalayas and the Alps, to receive and carry supplies through dangerous conditions more efficiently.

ropes and zip-line experience constructed completely in the trees. Enjoy five levels of adult courses and an 'Explorer' course for kids. All equipment and training are provided prior to your adventure.

Experience the longest zip-lines in the continental U.S. and the 4th and 6th longest in the world on the year-round Zip-Tour. Take a 2-hour journey covering almost 9,000 feet of dual zip-lines while you control your speed descending the mountain.
