video awards 2014

The goal of this contest is to provide an educational, team-building project for 4th grade students in which they can enjoy the creative challenge of condensing their message into a 60 second time frame.

TIMING:

All video clips must be returned to the video submission address by March 21, 2014.

ENTRY:

Go to visitnh.gov/classactvideoawards and completely fill out the application and release forms. These must be returned by March 31, 2014 enclosed with the video to be qualified to participate. Teachers must also include a completed **Entry Form** and **Model Release Forms**. Any student participating on film, voice or acting must have a release. Any other student not seen or heard, but does behind the scene work does not need to fill out a Model Release Form. Teachers are responsible for ensuring participation in this contest is approved by the student's parents or guardian.

PRIZES:

Winners will be provided with instructions of how to redeem prize following the winner public announcement. It is the responsibility of the teacher to coordinate directly with the prize sponsors.

FORMAT

Video clips must be mailed on DVD, CD or flash drive. Please ensure your class' video is in one of the following formats: WebM file, MPEG4, 3GPP, MOV, AVI, MPEGPS, WMV or FIV.



PARTICIPATION:

Only one video clip is permitted per individual 4th grade class. Individual 4th grade class is defined as one classroom and not the entire 4th grade student body. Each video clip cannot exceed 60 second time limit. Video credits can be included and can exceed the 60 second requirement however only the video itself up to 60 seconds will be viewed by the judging committee. Please be sure that the class' topic of choice and video clip is appropriate and does not include and offensive, racial, sexual and/or religious content. Any video clip containing inappropriate content will not qualify for the award prizes. Teachers must supervise class creation of the clip and assist where needed.
