GRANDMA BETTY'S MOLASSES CRINKLES

In a mixer, thoroughly combine $\frac{3}{4}$ cup shortening, 1 cup brown sugar, 1 egg and $\frac{1}{4}$ cup molasses. In a separate bowl, sift $2\frac{1}{4}$ cups all-purpose flour, 2 tsp. baking soda, $\frac{1}{4}$ tsp. salt, $\frac{1}{4}$ tsp. cloves, $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp. cinnamon and $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp. ginger. Gradually pour dry ingredients into molasses mixture and combine well.

Chill dough while preheating oven to 350° . Roll dough into $1\frac{1}{4}$ " balls and dip tops in granulated sugar. Place balls sugared side up 3 " apart on greased baking sheet. Bake 8 to 10 minutes at 350° , just until set but not hard. Cool on a wire rack and enjoy!

Makes about 20 cookies.

GRANDMA BETTY'S MOLASSES CRINKLES

In a mixer, thoroughly combine 3/4 cup shortening, 1 cup brown sugar, 1 egg and 1/4 cup molasses. In a separate bowl, sift 2 1/4 cups all-purpose flour, 2 tsp. baking soda, 1/4 tsp. salt, 1/4 tsp. cloves, 1/2 tsp. cinnamon and 1/2 tsp. ginger. Gradually pour dry ingredients into molasses mixture and combine well. Chill dough while preheating oven to 350°. Roll dough into 1 1/4" balls and dip tops in granulated sugar. Place balls sugared side up 3" apart on greased baking sheet. Bake 8 to

10 minutes at 350°, just until set but not hard. Cool on a wire rack and enjoy!

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
