



## WHAT'S THE REAL SCOOP... ON DAIRY?

#### **COW CARE**

- Dairy farmers' commitment to ensuring high-quality milk begins with taking good care of their cows and treating them with respect. The physical comfort of cows is just as important as their emotional comfort. Treating animals with respect and compassion is part of every dairy farmer's heritage.
- On average, dairy cows spend 45 minutes a day in the milking parlor. The rest of the time, they're on pasture, lazing about in the barn, socializing, eating, and drinking. Cows live extremely pampered lives.

#### **ENVIRONMENT**

Dairy farmers work to conserve resources such as water, land, and energy. Farmers have tools to measure soil, carbon, water, and energy to make decisions that help their farms use resources efficiently. Dairy farmers were environmentalists long before anyone else.

• Dairy farmers live on or near the land they farm. They understand the importance of protecting natural resources for future generations.

Practicing environmental stewardship is not only good for communities and families, it's the right thing to do. Dairy farmers remain committed to leaving a positive environmental


footprint for future generations.

#### **NUTRITION**

• When considering the numerous health benefits, the inexpensive cost per serving, and the amount of nutrients packed in each serving, dairy products are essential part of a healthy diet. There is no other beverage that naturally provides the same nutrients as real milk.

 Researchers at the University of Maine found that adults who consumed more dairy products scored "significantly" higher on memory and other cognitive tests than those who drank little to no milk. Those with high milk intake were five times less likely to fail the test compared to non-milk

drinkers.



• A study of over 37,000 middle aged women found that those with the highest intakes of low-fat dairy had a reduced risk of type 2 diabetes. Similarly, a study of men found a reduced risk of type 2 diabetes with increased consumption of low-fat dairy.

#### HORMONES AND ANTIBIOTICS

#### MILK DOES NOT CONTAIN ANTIBIOTICS. IT IS ILLEGAL.

All milk, both conventional and organic, is antibiotic free. Milk is tested three times before bottling. If it tests positive at any stage, it gets dumped and never enters the food supply.

HORMONES IN MILK? Hormones are simply chemical messengers produced naturally in both animal and plant foods— from celery to salmon to wheat and chicken. There are no "hormone-free" foods, including milk. Hormones are never added to milk. Milk is one of the simplest foods you can buy.



#### **NEW HAMPSHIRE'S AGRICULTURE**

Milk sales rank third in value of all New Hampshire agricultural commodities sold. (2020, NASS Agricultural Statistics Annual Bulletin)

The value of New Hampshire's total agricultural industry is approximately \$1.2 billion. This includes \$513.8 million in sales related to agricultural products and \$720.6 million in sales related to agritourism. (2021, The Economic Impact of Agriculture, New Hampshire 2019; 2021, The Economic Impact of Agritourism, New Hampshire, 2019)

Agriculture (production and agritourism) supports nearly 20,000 jobs in New Hampshire. (2021, The Economic Impact of Agriculture, 2019)

## NEW HAMPSHIRE DAIRY FACTS

- The New Hampshire dairy industry is located primarily in the Connecticut River Valley on the state's western borders and along the Merrimack River Valley in the center of the state. There are approximately 90 dairy farms in New Hampshire with an average of 120 milking animals per farm.
- Every glass of milk contributes jobs, income, and vitality to the community. The dairy industry in New Hampshire employs more than 5,000 skilled individuals, generates more than \$184 million in direct wages, and has an overall economic impact of \$1.89 billion on the state's economy.
- In 1990 New Hampshire was home to 275 family dairy farms. Today, approximately 90 remain. The cost of production has exceeded farm income for a prolonged period, causing a continuous decline in farm numbers.

#### **DID YOU KNOW:**

Fake milk may contain up to 12 added ingredients. Real dairy has three ingredients. Cow's milk, Vitamin A, and Vitamin D.

The largest source of ghg emissions in the U.S. is from burning fossil fuels for electricity, heat, and transportation. It's not the cows.

Real dairy delivers sustainable, accessible, and affordable food with unparalleled health and nutrition benefits.

#### WHERE'S YOUR MILK FROM?



New Hampshire is a milk deficit state. We don't produce what's needed to supply the state's growing population with enough dairy products. The more local farms we lose, the more milk we have to import.

How can you help? You should Check Your Jugs!!! Supporting local dairy farms is easy if you know what to look for.

Each container of milk is identified with a code near the sell by date. If you don't see it there, check the milk label. There is a two-digit state code followed by a two- or three-digit plant code.

If the code starts with 33, you can be sure your milk was locally sourced and produced in New Hampshire. Let's not lose the privilege to buy a fresh, local product. Remember to Check Your Jugs.
